## PROJECTS

**University Project Work:** Project work is the key element for all assignments in my course. The course covers a whole range of multimedia development techniques; from 3D graphics, audio/visual production and animation to MySQL Database, PHP and ActionScript 3.0. Second year at university was where I grasped a lot of the fundamental web design and development techniques and knowledge. From developing websites such as the dynamic content aggregated website called "FEED ME" (as shown on my website) using PHP and XML; to designing highly commercial and professional looking websites; and also Flash implementations of user immersive content coded with

ActionScript 3.0 and user interface designs. Final year of university was more programming in ActionScript 3.0 and development of 3D modelling, animations and games. The understanding of programming syntax and computer behaviour allowed me to create more dynamic and interactive material, and this is reflected in the work shown on my website.

**Website Development:** I found a gap where many Indian restaurateurs have not been using online advertisement to their full advantage due to lack of technological knowledge. My skills allow these restaurateurs to bridge the gap where I develop websites and other means online marketing which helps improve their business. Having successfully developed a number of websites to date, I am now well known by many of Bristol's Indian restaurateurs as the web designer of choice. Client satisfactions and recommendations has been a key factor to my success and reputation.

**Social Enterprise:** In college (6<sup>th</sup> form) I was given the opportunity to be a part of a business social enterprise project. The project was to develop and make awareness of a newly invented idea that will help to save people's lives. We came up with a concept, prototype and the actual finished product, then collectively organised a launch event. Others and myself presented this new product in front of community based organisations and the Avon Ambulance. This experience allowed me to have insight of a business-orientated project where my skills in communication and team management came in play. Utilising these skills with the team resulted in successfully launching this product and it still remains actively used by people around the Bristol area today.
